

Release notes

Summary

This document contains the updates included in Clinic version 4.173, Manage version 3.100 and the Medical content version 1.115. There are no updates on the Patient application in this release. The changes are expected to be launched to production on the 7th of May.

Clinic

Changes in version 4.173

- 1 Improved handling of asynchronous appointment closures
Clinic can be configured so that the practitioner must answer whether the appointment should be charged before it finishes. Previously, asynchronous appointments that automatically end after a certain number of days could not be closed without answering the charging question. Now, these appointments will automatically conclude without being marked as chargeable, unless otherwise specified.

Manage

Changes in version 3.100

- 1 New role for working with remote patient monitoring in Clinic
A new administrative Clinic role has been added called *Care Planner*. Having the role *Care Planner* means that the user has authorization to work with remote patient monitoring in Clinic, which includes authorization to:

- See the list of patients who are remotely monitored at a care unit
- Add a patient to a remote patient monitoring plan
- Make adjustments to an existing remote patient monitoring plan
- Be added as responsible practitioner on a remote patient monitoring plan


This change has been made to:

- Make authorization management easier
- Make authorization management more consistent with how other roles work in Platform24
- Facilitate future development of modular care plans

Please note that in order to be added as a responsible practitioner on a remote patient monitoring plan, the user must have the role *Care Planner*.

In order to give other users the role of *Care Planner* in Manage, the user needs to be administrator at the relevant care unit.

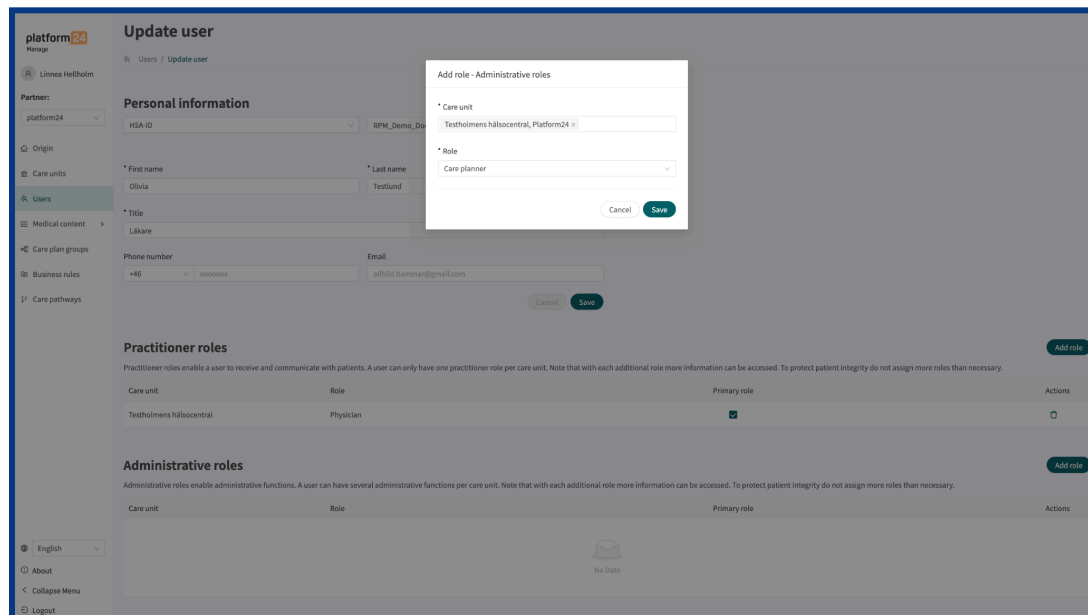

Changes in version 1.115

Medical content populating the Triage product

1 Large update of the questionnaire *pregnancy*

A complete overhaul with improvements throughout has been made in the questionnaire *pregnancy*. Minor changes have also been done in the questionnaire *bleeding during pregnancy*. The changes also implies that several symptoms in the questionnaire *gi* now refer to *pregnancy*, if you affirm pregnancy or might be pregnant. It concerns abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting and vomiting with blood.

Several additional safety exits have been added. Including that you should never be able to get a lower exit than “Planned” for symptoms such as depression, headache and cough, and never a lower exit than “Acute” for urinary tract problems. The image below shows the questionnaires’ initial question.

The changes apply directly upon release for all customers who use the questionnaires mentioned.

2 Change in the questionnaire *jaw*

An improvement has been made in the questionnaire *jaw*, to better catch patients who have jaw pain and symptoms associated with the heart, but who have no symptoms from the chest.
