

1 Async meeting update

A change has been made to the data point "started async appointments" which will impact the data point when meetings were started. This is to align when the practitioner receives the patient instead of when the meeting was created by the patient. This will result in that some async appointments change starting dates.

This change will be applied to all customers in the Metabase Standard report after the release notes have been sent out.
