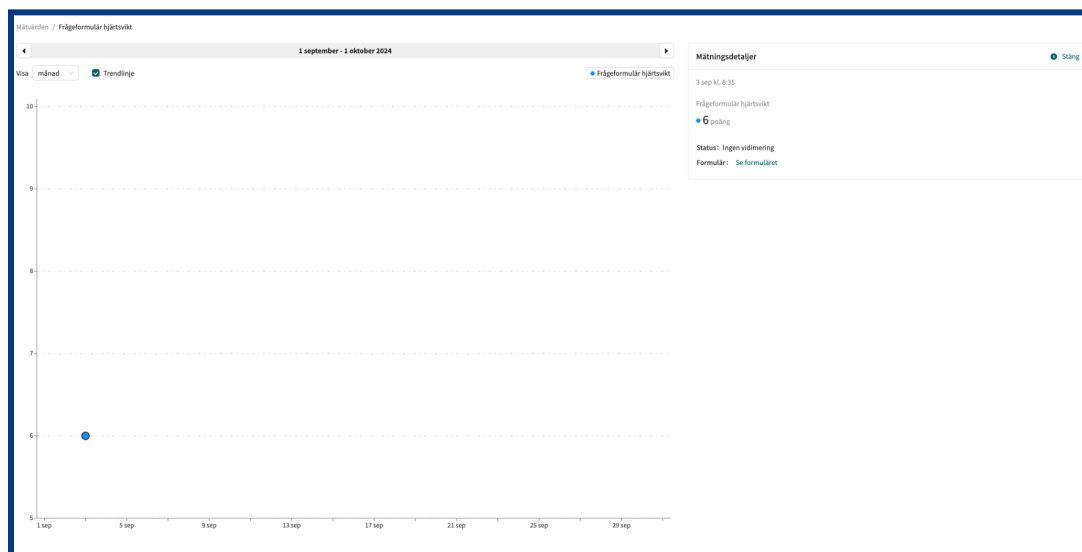

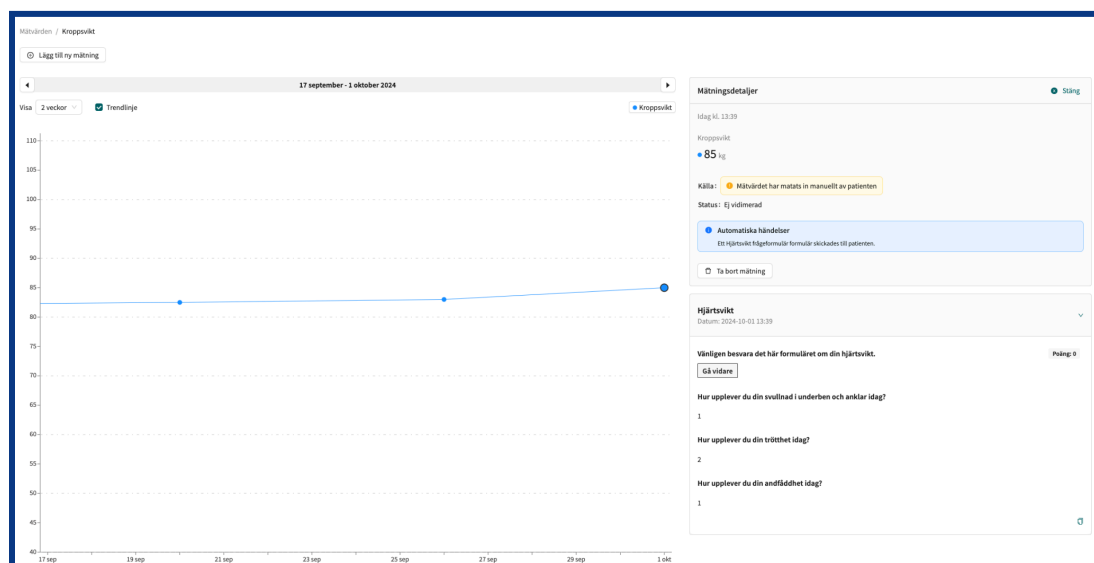
Changes in version 4.195

- 1 Triggered questionnaires are visible in the measurement graph for remote patient monitoring, and new look for questionnaires in the graphs

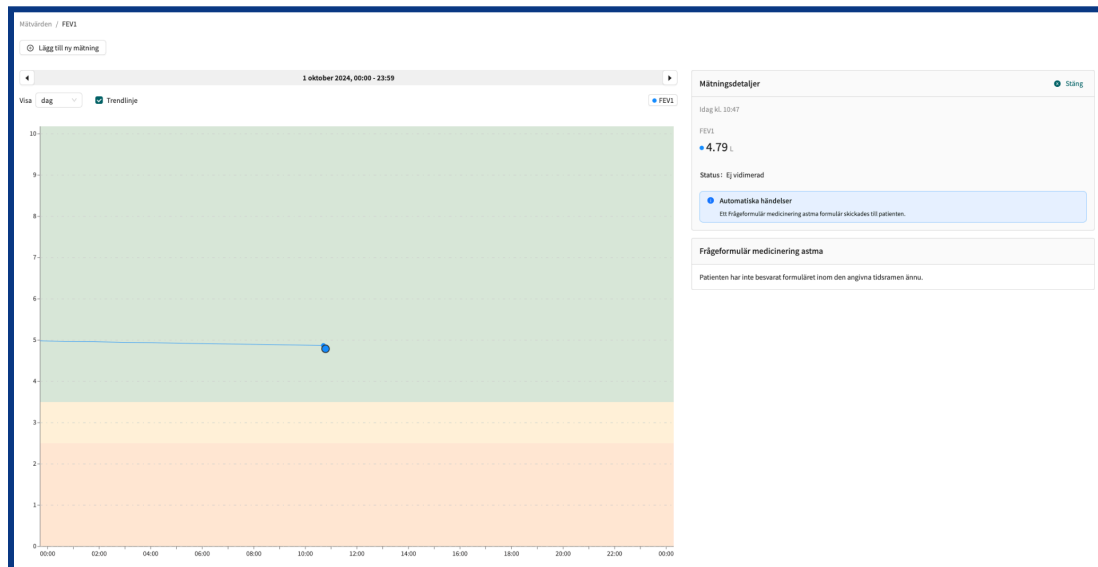
Some care plans have automatic events configured to automatically trigger a questionnaire for the patient. An example is a heart failure questionnaire that is automatically triggered if a heart failure patient experiences a rapid weight gain. Previously, the result from the measurement (in this case, the weight) and the questionnaire were displayed in two separate graphs. Now, the questionnaire will appear in the measurement graph that triggered the questionnaire (in this example, in the weight graph). Note that the questionnaire will still appear in its own graph to allow the questionnaire's trend to be tracked separately, just as before. The appearance of questionnaires in general has also been adjusted so that questionnaire responses are displayed directly when the user clicks on a point in the graph. Previously, healthcare personnel had to click "See questionnaire answers" to view the responses. See images in Swedish below.



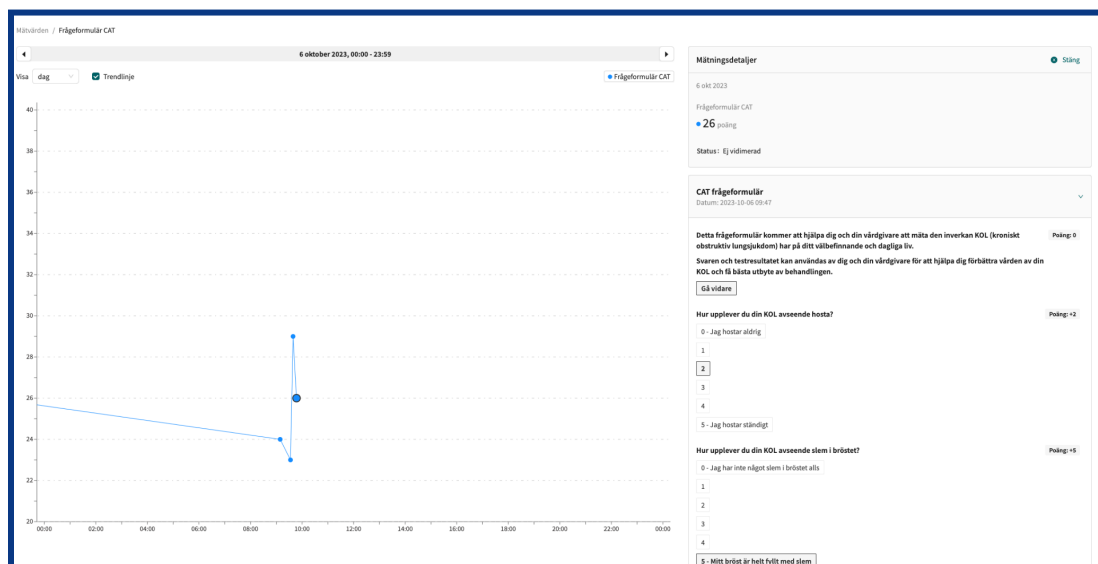
Before: The healthcare personnel had to click on “See the questionnaire answers” to view the responses.



After: The triggered questionnaire is displayed directly in the graph for the measurement that triggered the questionnaire.



After: Information is also given if the patient has not answered the questionnaire yet.



After: The questionnaire is now shown directly when a user clicks a point in the graph.



Medical content populating the Triage product

The following changes apply directly upon release for all customers who use the questionnaires mentioned.

1 Exit added in the questionnaire *bite tick*

To improve safety an exit has been added in the questionnaire *bite tick*. It concerns a tick that cannot be removed, which should at least give the urgency level "acute".

2 Options added in the questionnaire *urinary*

Two options are added in the questionnaire *urinary*, concerning diagnoses for anatomical abnormalities of the urinary tract and neurological diseases affecting bladder emptying.

New options in the questionnaire *urinary*, in Swedish.

— Vad menar vi med svarsalternativen?

Njurbäckeninflammation är en urinvägsinfektion som spridit sig till en eller båda njurarna.

Neurologisk sjukdom som påverkar blåstömningen innebär en sjukdom som gör det svårare för kroppen att kontrollera när och hur du kissar. Detta kan leda till att du har svårt att tömma blåsan helt eller att du har läckage.

Anatomisk avvikelse i urinvägarna betyder att det finns en skillnad i hur dina urinvägar är uppbyggda jämfört med vad som är normalt, vilket kan påverka hur urin passerar genom kroppen.

3 Improvement in the questionnaires *gi* and *rectal*

An improvement has been made in the questionnaires *gi* and *rectal*, to facilitate the triage for rectal leakage with suspected neurological cause. When choosing rectal leakage the patient is then able to choose among the neurological symptoms shown in the picture below; reduced feel in the genital area, problems with bladder emptying and back pain.

2 Dashboard+: Updates in Efficiency and Ratings report

All customers who have Dashboard+ in Metabase included in their contract and have the "Efficiency and Rating" report will automatically receive the following updates:

- A new filter at the top of the report that allows filtering by *Search reason*
- In the *Per Meeting* card, the following columns are added for each meeting:
 - Date when the meeting was placed in the queue.
 - How many days passed between the patient entering the queue and the meeting being completed
