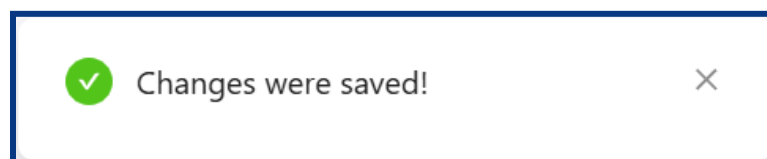

1 Improved exit texts

All exit texts have been improved. After the text “Thanks for your response!” they now begin with “The recommendation on the next page is based on..”. They have also been improved regarding spelling and grammar. The change was done to give patients and practitioners a better understanding of why a certain exit has been chosen.

Note that the changes regarding release 1.132 will be released this week (week 46).

The following changes apply directly upon release for all customers who use the questionnaires mentioned.

- 1 New questionnaire for handling drainage, catheters, gastrostomy ports and PEG:s

A new questionnaire has been developed, named *drainCatheterTube*, to better and more safely handle the problems that could arise with drainage, catheters, gastrostomy ports and PEG:s. Before the change, the handling of urinary catheters was built into other questionnaires, for example *urinary*.



2 Exits added for bariatric surgery

New questions and exits have been added for bariatric surgery (weight loss surgery) that was performed within the last 6 months. Affected questionnaires are *acidReflux*, *gi* and *postOp*.
