Summary

This document contains the updates included in Clinic version 4.210, Manage version 3.130, the Medical content version 1.141 and also an accessibility statement for the Patient application. The changes are expected to be launched to production on the 4th of February.

Patient application

1 Accessibility statement

This document (attached as a PDF in the Release notes email sent out to customers) provides a detailed overview of the current accessibility status of our Patient app, covering both the web and native apps. Our goal is to offer a transparent view of where the app currently stands in terms of accessibility, as well as which areas still require improvement.

We have prepared this statement using a structured template to make it easier for you to assess the app's compliance with accessibility standards. The document highlights the remaining gaps in accessibility and can be used to inform your own accessibility communications.

Summary of our accessibility work

Attached is the latest update of our accessibility status for the patient app. Over the past year, we have resolved several previously widespread issues. Most of the remaining issues are isolated, and we are actively working to address all identified gaps, with a priority on those that have the greatest impact on users.

Accessibility work is an ongoing effort, and we remain committed to continuously improving the apps. We conduct annual audits in collaboration with Axess Lab and follow an iterative process to ensure consistent progress.



Review brand colors and contrast

We encourage you to review the colors used in the Patient app, which are often brand colors, to ensure they meet WCAG contrast requirements. If adjustments are needed to achieve sufficient contrast, please let us know which new colors should be applied. We recommend tools such as WebAIM Contrast Checker to quickly verify and optimize contrast levels.

Select colors for dark mode

As we prepare for dark mode, we need to add primary and secondary colors for all customers. If you already have colors optimized for dark mode, please send them to us.

If no colors are provided, we will select them for you, but you will have the option to update them later if needed. The colors must have sufficient contrast against the background color #262626 (dark gray).



1 Error message for too big file size


An error message has been added to inform you if the file you are trying to upload is too big.

2 Updated design and improved sorting for attestations


The attestations view has been redesigned with updated headers and a new sorting structure for better overview and management.

- **Renamed tabs**: The "Incoming" tab is now named "To attest", to clearly indicate that these tasks are active and require practitioner attention.
- **New tab:** The "Upcoming" tab replaces the old "Assigned to me" tab, and displays scheduled attestations for both you and your colleagues. This provides better visibility of future tasks.
- Improved sorting: Attestations are now divided into two clear categories:
 - **To attest** Current attestations that need to be handled now. These are sorted by priority.
 - Upcoming Attestations scheduled for the future, including those assigned to colleagues. These are sorted in ascending order based on the scheduled date.



• Quick selection for a personalized view: A direct link and a shortcut in the resource selector make it easier to filter and view your own attestations.

This update creates a more structured and easy-to-navigate attestations view, making planning and management more efficient.







1 Improved handling of free text questions

An informative text is added in the questionnaire *otherSymptom*, which is reached by choosing "none from above" in the list of symptoms. A free text question is also removed in the questionnaire *chestPain* and one in the questionnaire *urinary*, which concerned a patients' own description of chest issues and of the localisation of pain respectively.

The informative text in the questionnaire *otherSymptom* reads: "Please note that the information you provide in this question does not affect the recommendation you receive about when you should seek care".

The changes apply directly upon release for all customers, except for those with partner-specific questionnaires.
