
Updated information about Triage24 MDR product

The text is now supported in the following languages: Swedish, English, Danish, Dutch, German and Norwegian.






# 2 New text field on *Feedback and support* page

Contact your Customer Success Manager to add text to the text field (optional) in the languages supported by your Patient application.










# 1 Updated design of child label

The label indicating that the patient is a child has a new design to align with other labels on the new pages of the main menu.

The label is shown on the same pages and with the same logic: the label is displayed when a guardian is acting on behalf of their child and is only shown for customers that have relationship check activated.



Free-text questions moved post-triage in the questionnaire recurringHeadache

Release notes

Adjustments have been made in the questionnaire *recurringHeadache*. Anamnesis-gathering free-text questions that were not asked for triaging purposes have been moved post-triage. The question in the picture is an example that is shown post-triage if you answer that you have a diagnosis but then negate all examples given.

The changes apply directly upon release for all customers, except for those with partner-specific questionnaires.
