

Changes in version 4.223

1 Participant card in the appointment view

We have added a participant card to all appointment views. Video appointments already include a similar list of participants. In order to harmonise the user experience across all meeting types, we have now added this card to other meeting types as well.

Participants

The new card helps you see who is participating in a meeting. It includes two types of participants:

1. **Responsible practitioner** – Each ongoing meeting has one responsible practitioner. If the meeting has not been received yet, you will see a placeholder: *No responsible practitioner assigned yet.*
2. **Other practitioners** – Lists any other practitioners (Clinic users) participating in the meeting.

"Invited practitioners" changed to "Other practitioners"

Note: This is mainly relevant for customers using video appointments.

We have renamed the term *Invited practitioners* (previously used in video appointments) to *Other practitioners* to ensure consistency across all meeting types. This is because practitioners can join a meeting without being explicitly invited, for example by adding themselves.

Edit participants

You can now manage meeting participants directly from the participant card using the “Edit participants” feature. This is the same view used in video appointments, ensuring a consistent user flow.


This feature serves the same purpose as the icon at the top of the chat

 . Both options will be available for a while, but we plan to keep only the *Edit participants* feature in the long term.

Handover information

A handover is the process of changing the responsible practitioner of a meeting. When a handover is proposed, you will now see relevant information directly in the participant card.

Take over

The *Take over* feature allows a practitioner to become the responsible practitioner in an asynchronous meeting. This is not a new feature, but we have moved the button into the participant card to group all actions related to management of participants in one place.
