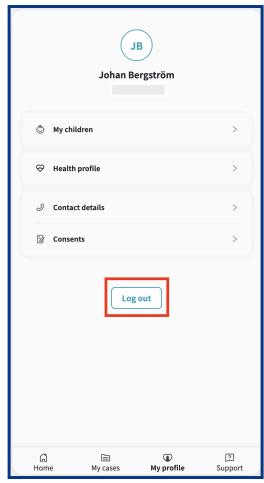

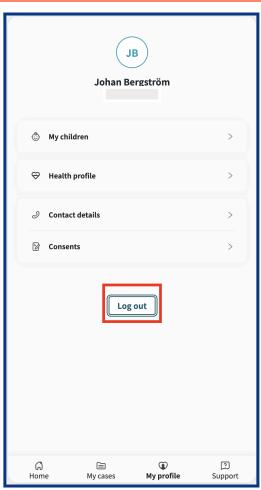
Changes in version 1.260

Updated design for the Log out button on My Profile

As part of our ongoing work to implement a new design system across the entire Patient app, all components are being gradually updated. In this release, we have improved the design and contrast of the Log out button. This update aligns with the new design system and also reinforces our commitment to accessibility.

Design updates to the Patient app will continue step by step. Major changes will be communicated through future release notes.

Changes in version 1.154

Medical content populating the Triage product

1 Adjusted triage regarding breathing difficulties

The previous grading of breathing difficulties as mild, moderate or severe is removed.

The grading will now be assessed based on the severity in situations where symptoms are experienced. The examples are taken from the app when an adult patient seeks help for respiratory problems:

- In the context of exercise or physical activity
- When I go up the stairs (1-2 floors)
- When walking on flat ground
- When I get dressed
- When I speak or say some sentences
- When I am resting
- None of the above

The changes have been made in the following questionnaires:

- libraryAirwaysBreathing
- breathing
- cough
- flu

2 Improved presentation of Centor criteria

After feedback from customers, the presentation of Centor criteria has been improved in the SmartText. The Centor criteria are now shown in a separate section and the SmartText also shows when fever has not been affirmed.



3 Lowered over-triage in the questionnaire *palpitation*

Improvements have been made in the questionnaire *palpitation*. The exit for palpitation and fatigue has been identified as one of the exits most responsible for over-triage.

Urgency has now been lowered when affirming palpitations and fatigue/tiredness without any other alarming symptoms.

4 Improvements in the questionnaire *earSymptoms*

Improvements have been made in the questionnaire *earSymptoms* for patients seeking care for sudden hearing loss caused by trauma or loud noises.

What is included in the release notes is what is intended to be released. Be aware that the development is currently under regression testing and have to pass the tests in order to be released. Therefore, if a change is made to the release that will affect what is written in the release notes, a new version of release notes will be communicated.
