Clinic

Changes in version 4.244

1 Easier to add practitioners to conference calls

This change only applies to customers using conference calls.

We have made improvements regarding how to add and edit practitioners in conference calls. We have separated the selection of responsible practitioners from adding other practitioners, which will reduce the clicks needed and make the process of adding practitioners to conference calls easier.

Changes in version 1.160

Medical content populating the Triage product

1 Improvement of the question about affected general condition

When the patient is asked about affected general condition, a new question has been added after the current question. The purpose with this change is to collect data on how patients answer the question to ultimately reduce over-triage. If the initiative leads to the desired results, the goal is to replace the old question about affected general condition with the new question.

The new question is now asked in all questionnaires where the question about affected general condition is asked, *except* in the questionnaires *breathing* and *cough*, or where the patient is redirected to these questionnaires.

The age limit for receiving the new question is set to 8 years and above. Children 7 years and younger will still receive only the old question.

The patient now receives the urgency level “Immediate” if a total of three or more of the statements below have been selected, *or* if a severely affected general condition has been previously selected via the old question. The choice “none of the above” is not counted in the score.

If the patient has selected two statements or fewer, *and* severely affected general condition has not been previously selected via the old question, the patient receives the urgency level “Promptly”.

The new question is phrased:

Does any of the following apply to you?

- Unable to eat or drink
- Unable to sit up for 10 minutes
- Unable to get dressed or go to the toilet
- Unable to think clearly or communicate
- None of the above

The changes apply directly upon release for all customers, except for those with customer-specific questionnaires.

Observe!

What is included in the release notes is what is intended to be released. Be aware that the development is currently under regression testing and have to pass the tests in order to be released. Therefore, if a change is made to the release that will affect what is written in the release notes, a new version of release notes will be communicated.
