

Release notes

Summary

This document contains the updates included in the Medical content version 1.162. There are no updates on the Patient application, Clinic or Manage in this release. The changes are expected to be launched to production on the 7th of October.

Medical Content

Changes in version 1.162

Medical content populating the Triage product

The changes apply directly upon release for all customers, except for those with customer-specific questionnaires.

Improvements to handling of diabetes and symptoms of diabetes

Improvements have been made:

- To the flow in the questionnaire *chronic* for patients searching for diabetes as a diagnosis, and for symptoms of diabetes.
- To the questionnaires *incontinence*, *urinary* and *urinaryChanges*, to update and align handling of possible signs of diabetes with focus on increased volumes of urine and increased thirst.
- To align with other questionnaires how patients with increased volumes of urine or other signs that could be a symptom of diabetes are handled in the questionnaire *genitalMaleFemale*.



2 Changes to the questionnaire headache

Changes have been made to the questionnaire *headache* to better align with RGS guidance and to reduce over-triage.

Changes made:

- Adjusted urgency levels for headache-related exits regarding the RGS advice 'recurrent nocturnal headache or morning headache'.
- Adjusted urgency levels for headache-related exits regarding headache after lumbar puncture.
- Refined handling of headache with personality changes.

3 Edits to oral questionnaires regarding swelling

Minor edits have been made to sync how the handling of swelling in mouth and chin are handled in the oral flows. The changes have been made to the questionnaires *gum*, *oralCavity*, *postDental* and *teeth*.

4 Improvements to the questionnaire eyeVision

Minor improvements have been made to the questionnaire *eyeVision* for patients with affected vision. Improvements have also been made in the autoanamnesis for this questionnaire.

5 Edited age condition for pregnancy/postpartum responses

Minor edits have been made in the questionnaire *abnormalBleeding* so that questions and responses concerning pregnancy, postpartum and abortion are conditioned to be asked from the age of 12 and upwards and if the patient has had their first period.



Other changes in medical content

Improved autoanamnesis for shoulder complaints

Based on feedback, the autoanamnesis for shoulder complaints has been improved. It now shows whether the patient's left shoulder, right shoulder, or both shoulders are affected.

What is included in the release notes is what is intended to be released. Be aware that the development is currently under regression testing and have to pass the tests in order to be released. Therefore, if a change is made to the release that will affect what is written in the release notes, a new version of release notes will be communicated.
