Correction of last week's release notes: The Medical content concerned version 1.161, but was written incorrectly as version 1.162.

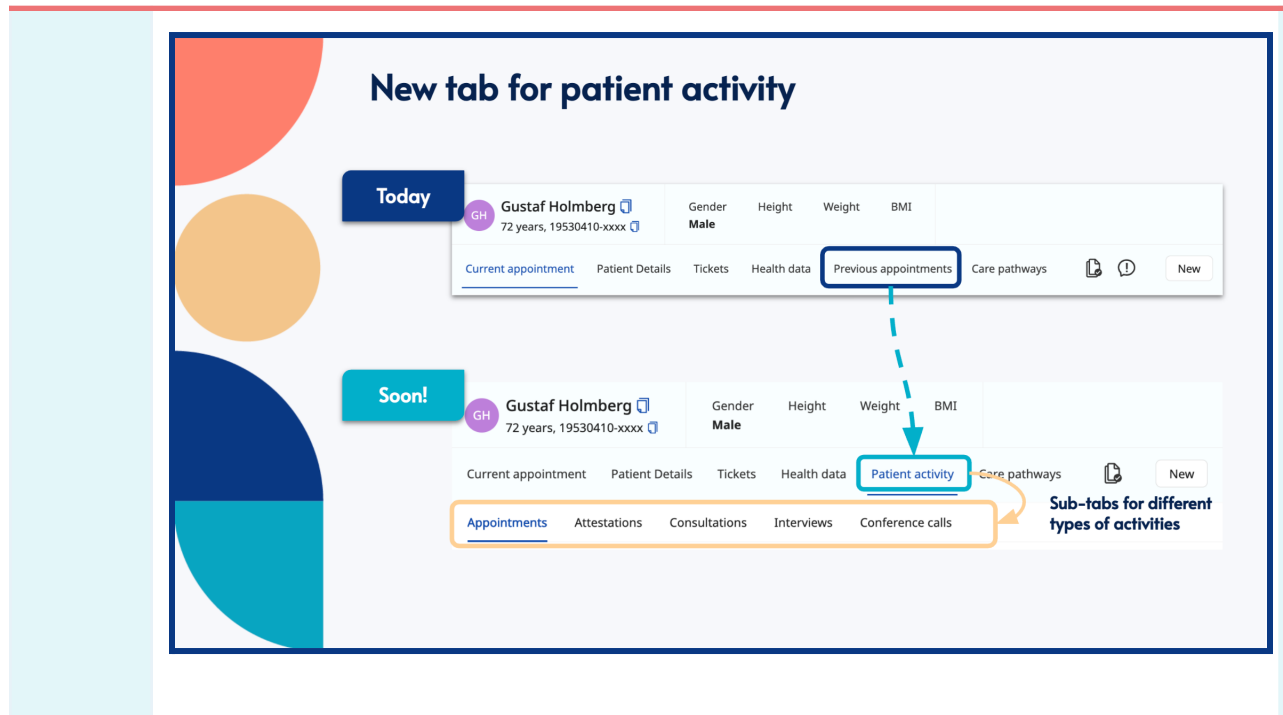

Changes in version 4.247

1 Patient activity

This feature has been active for a sub-set of customers and is now activated for all remaining customers. Details about the feature have been sent out separately. For more information, reach out to customer support.

We have replaced "Previous appointments" with a new feature called "Patient activity". In the Patient activity tab, different types of activities are divided into sub-tabs, making it easier to get an overview of the patient's activities. This feature also provides more information in the list making it easier for the user to find the relevant activities.



Medical Content

Changes in version 1.162

Correction of last week's release notes: Concerned version 1.161, but was written incorrectly as version 1.162.

Medical content populating the Triage product

The changes apply directly upon release for all customers who use the questionnaires mentioned, except for those with customer-specific questionnaires.

1 Improvements to the questionnaire *soreThroat*

Improvements have been made to the questionnaire *soreThroat* to reduce over-triage. The improvements concern questions handling patients with difficulties swallowing:

- First the patient is asked *if* they have difficulties swallowing saliva.
- Then one new question has been added that asks in what *way* it's difficult to swallow saliva, with the response options *can swallow saliva but it hurts*, *can swallow saliva but it feels tight*, and *can't swallow saliva*.
- The response option *can swallow saliva but it hurts* is considered normal and does not lead to follow up questions about drooling or breathing difficulties.

2 RGS update to the questionnaire *urinary*

An update has been made in the questionnaire *urinary*, where the age to be handled as an adult woman with urinary tract infection has been set to 15 years old instead of 13, to conform with RGS. Furthermore, no ages are mentioned anymore in our self-care advice for women with urinary tract infection.

Other changes in medical content

1 Improvement to the sick note flow

An improvement has been made to the sick note flow so that a question about start date is added when the sick note is sent out from Clinic.

Observe!

What is included in the release notes is what is intended to be released. Be aware that the development is currently under regression testing and have to pass the tests in order to be released. Therefore, if a change is made to the release that will affect what is written in the release notes, a new version of release notes will be communicated.
